## Why the Request for Deadline Extension of June 2024?

> Continue compliance efforts for the remaining 107 MIDs
> Moving from Govolution to Fiserv's Payment Gateway for e-commerce sites takes 6-8 weeks per merchant environment

- Reduces complexity of merchant's SAQ reporting obligation
- Removes State network from scope
- Shifts liability to vendor partners
> Supply chain delays caused a several month delay in receiving P2PE devices
- New devices need to be deployed and installed prior for new SAQ category to be assigned
> Agency resources are strained
- Takes time to schedule and coordinate compliance efforts
- Competing projects, initiatives, and priorities
